- The Blast at Snapper Inn 1200 – 1500
- Pre-cruise; we'll continue The Blast on *Haven* with the "Margaritaville" rendezvous. While this is an RV, we'll be stuffed from The Blast, so no need to bring an appetizer. *Haven* will anchor opposite The View due to draft restrictions.
- Pump Out: Town of Islip pump out boat on CH 73; \$5 credit card only- this may be waived; bring cash to tip

 - Mention you are part of the SBCC cruise
 - Low tide is 0951, high tide is 1617 on Wednesday and checkout is 1000
 - Fortunately, this is the higher high tide for the day. At 1430 the expected height of the tide will be the same as the lower high tide for that day.
 - If applicable, put in your reservation that you need a late checkout due to draft. You may get charged for a partial day.
 - *Haven* plans on leaving at 1415 on Wednesday
 - \$3.75/ft Sunday, \$1.75/ft Monday and Tuesday
 - 3 night special gets you a food voucher that is 15% of your dockage total
 - Electric 50A/120V – \$14/day; 50A/208V – \$18/day
 - You will need your own adapter for 30A boats, see Dockwa link above

 - Ferry Arrives Approx. 1205, Departs 1215
 - Ferry Arrives Approx. 1350, Departs 1400

 - The on-site pump out has been broken for years. The dock master does not expect it ever to get fixed.
 - Town of Brookhaven pump out boat on CH 73, only on weekends, don't plan on getting it after we arrive
